What is a Small Church Community?

Small Church Communities (known as SCC) are gatherings of 8-12 people who freely choose to form a community of faith and fellowship. They will meet twice a month, normally in members' homes, for a two hour period. During this time participants will have the chance to come to know each other on a deeper level, reflect upon how God is working in their lives, thereby connecting faith with daily life. There is also time for socializing, prayer and food. In our large parishes of today, knowing other parishioners is becoming more difficult. Being a member of a small church community assures you that you are known and prayed for by this community, and that you have the additional support of this new family.
