## EXPLANATION OF CHARITIES ON GIVING TREE ORNAMENTS

Each year various charities are included as options for donations through the 'GIVING TREE'.

A brief explanation of the charities follows:

1. Holy Childhood - Donations are collected world-wide for needs of the Catholic Missions. These funds are distributed through the Holy Childhood Association and our local contact is Sister Demetria Smith, O.S.L.A., long-time African missionary from the Archdiocese of Indianapolis.
2. St. Vincent DePaul – These donations are forwarded to our parish St. Vincent DePaul Society for use in their ministry to the poor and needy in our parish boundaries.
3. Holy Cross – These donations are used by the Holy Cross Parish for the needs of children in their parish and neighborhood.
4. St. Philip Neri Neighborhood. These donations are used by the Missionary Sisters of Charity (Mother Theresa's Nuns) for the poor and homeless in the St. Philip neighborhoods. The gifts are used by the parish office for their out-reach ministries.
5. Catholic Charities – These donations are used to provide articles for the "Christmas Store" that is operated by Catholic Charities (in the Xavier Building) for the needs of the downtown poor.
5. African Children – These donations are sent through Fr. Jim Farrell to support an orphanage in Africa for children whose parents have both died of aids. The orphanage is run by Sr. Paoli, an Italian Missionary.
6. Mexican Children – These donations are sent to a village in Mexico where they are used to provide meals to street children.
7. SPRED – These donations are used for our parish SPRED Group. SPRED is a ministry to young adults within our parish with special needs. They meet for classes every-other-Sunday Afternoon, plan occasional group activities and participate in Archdiocesan events.
8. Needy Parish Families: These gifts are used to help parish families in need of assistance. We provide gifts and clothing for children whose parents ask for help.
9. Outreach at the Parish Door: These monies are used to purchase "KROGER CARDS" which are given out at the front door to those begging for help.
