As you may have noticed the windows in the Parish Center are **SLOWLY** being replaced! It has proven to be a more difficulty job than was first thought so rather than replacing five windows per day, it is three windows per day! They look great and will match the new windows in the school that were installed a few years ago.

Speaking of windows, one of the projects that was left undone during the renovation of the church 20 years ago, was the replacing of the windows in the chapel. Through the support of several donations given for this purpose, we will be replacing the windows with leaded glass windows using a "sacraments" theme. With the large etched glass window of the Holy Spirit serving as the Confirmation window, the remaining six windows will represent the sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist, Reconciliation, Holy Orders, Marriage and Anointing of the Sick. We have signed a contract and the windows should be installed sometime this Fall. I think you will really like them!
